Camp Details...

Housing: Get ready to experience college life! Campers will enjoy the use of Liberty University dorms and the food court-style cafeteria. Churches will be placed together in the same halls (boys and girls separate dorms).

Rec:

- **Organized Rec:** This year, ALL campers will participate in daily organized activities such as wacky relays, silly sports and water games at a new "cooled-down" time schedule.
- **Free Time:** In addition to hang time with buddies, churches may want to take advantage of the full usage of beautiful Liberty University campus. You will be free to organize activities such as tennis, volleyball, softball, etc. Also available is the Lahaye Student Center which offers pool tables, ping-pong, basketball, swimming pool and ice rink (*some reservation & additional charges may apply*).

Family Bible Study Groups: Students will be divided into family groups of up to 25 campers. Camp staffers and other adult leaders will facilitate group Bible studies and personal devotion time. The groups will be divided age appropriately and contain students not only from your church, but from several other churches.

Break Out Sessions: Youth pastors will choose seminars for their church on a variety of topics. These are excellent avenues to bring Biblical solutions to today's teen/world issues.

Worship: Campers will encounter God through worship every morning and evening. With many of the nation's top speakers, worship leaders and drama, our worship services serve as the foundation for creating powerful spiritual impact.

Church Group Time: Every evening following the worship service, church groups will meet together for essential fellowship and to discuss daily reflections. This is an important time for you to get feedback from your students, to pray with them, engage them in meaningful conversation or just hang out.

Adult Leaders: Adult chaperones/volunteers that come with your church in 2007 will be called "adult leaders". Many opportunities will be made available for these adults to assist the camp staff in areas such as Family Groups, Organized Rec, and more. These areas are noted on the adult leader registration form.

Camp Staff: Our staff of approximately 60 dedicated youth pastors, summer missionaries, young professionals, and highly trained college/seminary students makes the difference as they teach and mentor Christ-likeness. And this doesn't even count the hundreds of quality camp volunteers that will come with their churches to impact students at camp.

Missions Track...

A missions track is offered as an option for churches desiring a missions emphasis at camp. Campers will have the opportunity to put their faith in action by serving in backyard Bible clubs, prayer walks, neighborhood canvassing, handing out tracts and more. Churches choosing this track will be trained during break out sessions and receive limited free time.
